

**“Jesus: The True Son of God
Has Authority Over All Things”**

Luke 4:1-13

**How does Jesus prove he is the Son of
God?**

Satan attacks Jesus 3 times and all three times Jesus fights by quoting from the book of Deuteronomy!

Jesus is intentionally contrasting himself with the Israelites who were supposed to prove that they were God's children (son) by obeying him and following his commands!

Jesus proves that he is the Son of God by
being obedient to His Father!

**How Is Satan *Crushed* In This
Passage?**

Philippians 2:9-11

*God has highly exalted him and bestowed on him the name that is above every name, so that at the name of Jesus every knee should bow, in heaven and on the earth and under the earth, and every tongue confess that Jesus Christ is Lord, to the **Glory of God the father.***

Exodus 17:7

And he called the name of the place Massah and Meribah, because of the quarreling of the people of Israel, and because they tested the Lord by saying, “is the Lord among us or not?”

For Satan, getting to Jesus to deny and question the sovereignty of God was at the heart of all three of his attacks.

But What About Satan's Scripture Quote

- **And Jesus answered him**, “It is written, ‘Man shall not live by bread alone.’” Quoted from Deuteronomy 8:3
- **And Jesus answered him**, “It is written, “You shall worship the Lord your God, and him only shall you serve.” Quoting Deuteronomy 6:5
- **And Jesus answered him**, “It is said, ‘You shall not put the Lord your God to the test.’” Quoted from Deuteronomy 6:16
- **Satan's use of Scripture**: “If you are the Son of God, throw yourself down from here, for it is written, “He will command his angels concerning you, to guard you,’ and “On their hands they will bear you up, lest you strike your foot against a stone.” Quoted from Psalm 91:11,12

All of the Bible, not just Psalm 91 spells out the victory of Christ and the defeat of evil so therefore any passage at all that Satan can apply will spell out his defeat.
