Questions for Study and Reflection

1. Pastor Charlie said that the reason he took so long in Ephesians 5:15-21 is because he wanted to lay a foundation for understanding the fullness of worship. Do you feel like you have a better understanding of what worship is now? Why not or how so?
2. How does growing in your understanding of worship serve to increase your joy in Christ?
3. Pastor Charlie said that Ephesians 5:22-6:9 build on 5:21. Do you see this connection as well? How would you describe the connection?
4. Why is it right to say that the main subject of Ephesians 5:22-6:9 is worship?
5. Pastor Charlie has used two metaphors for worship over the last several months. Do you remember what they are? If so, do you think they're good metaphors? (If you don't remember what they are ask a friend at Glory of Christ!)
6. How does keeping the supremacy of Christ over all things in mind help us in our daily relationships, for example, husbands and wives, parents and children, employers and employees?
7. Pastor Charlie said that all the verses of Ephesians 5:22-6:9 are for all of us, even if they don't immediately relate to our life situation. Do you think this is true? What does your answer say about the nature of the Bible?
8. In preparation for next week please spend some time meditating on the following verses: 1 Cor. 11:3, 14:34; Eph. 5:22-24; Col. 3:18; Titus 2:5; 1 Peter 3:1-6.
